- Outside Mrs Holt class (Louis Armstrong)
- By Miss Probert's door (Aretha Franklin).

*How could we make them interactive?*

- Music buttons (Talk tins)
- Finish the lyrics
- Questions & answers in envelopes
- Boards on wheels / easels so they are portable.
- Questions on whiteboards and children create a mind map around the question with their ideas. e.g. What do you know about?

*Ideas for additional famous musicians:* Micheal Jackson, Freddie Mercury, Elton John, Ed Sheeran, Adele, Stevie Wonder, Ariande Grande, Bob Marley
